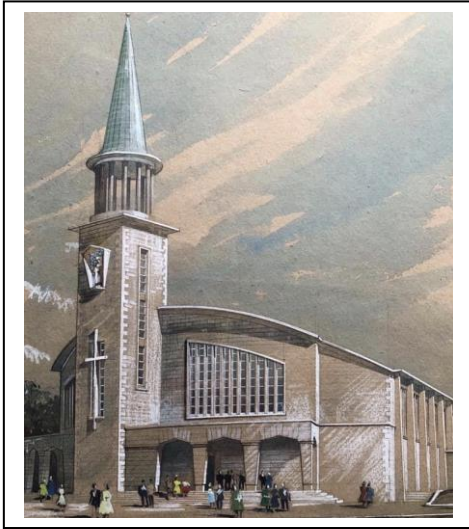

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Reflection

We see that Jesus is moved with pity for this man in Mark's Gospel and reaches out to him, and stretches out his hand in love.

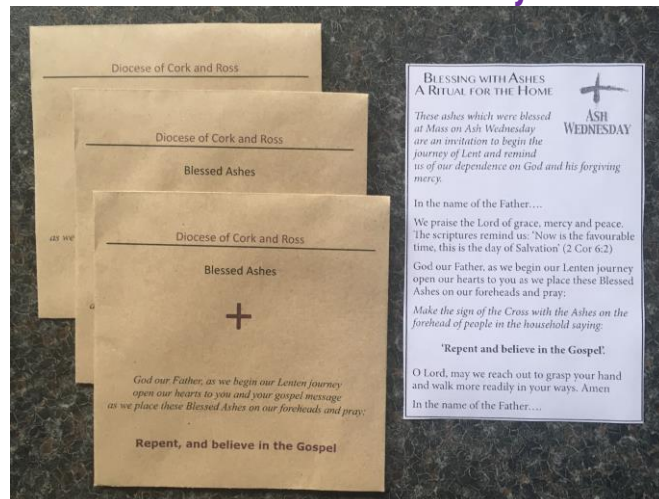

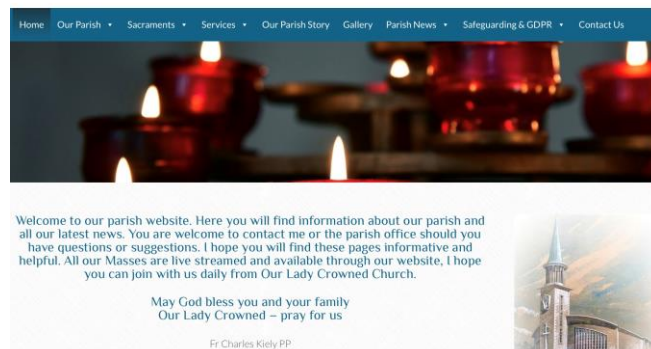

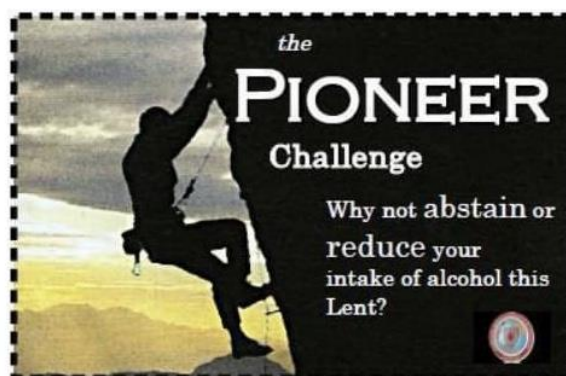
