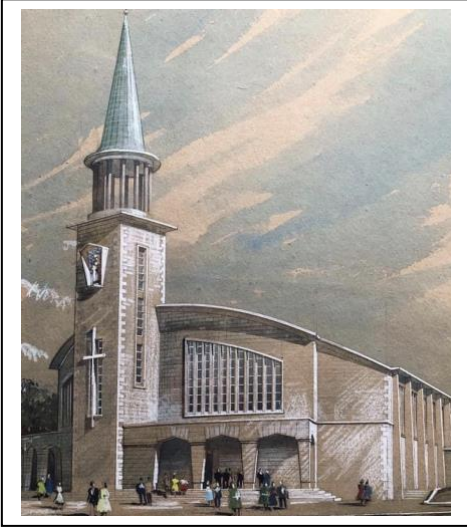

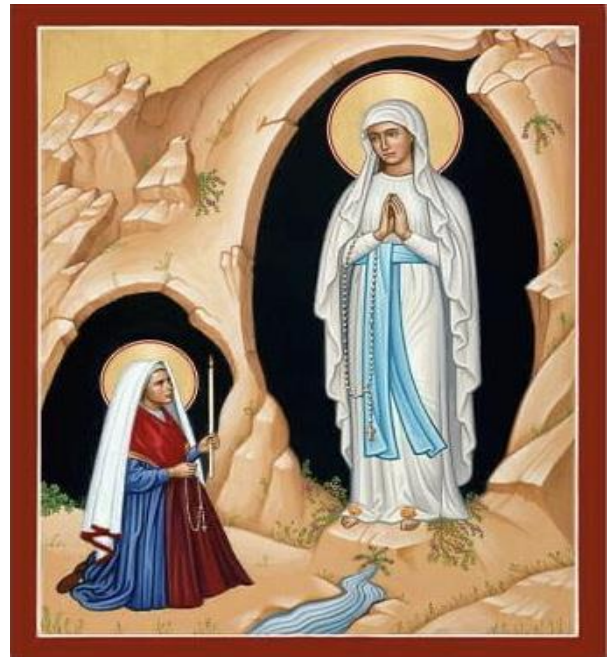

## Day for Consecrated Life 2021

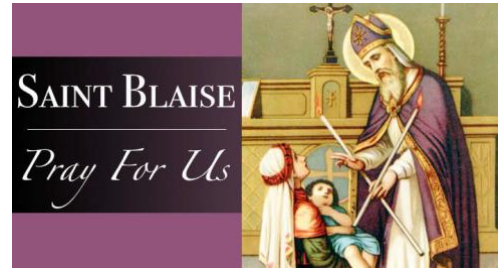
Last year over 200 religious, sisters, brothers and clergy from throughout the Diocese joined in a celebration of consecrated life in the Cathedral of St. Mary and St. Anne on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord at the invitation of Bishop Fintan. That day is the one chosen by late Pope Saint John Paul for the celebration of consecrated life.

This year Bishop Fintan Gavin has invited the religious sisters, brothers and clergy to join with him virtually on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> February at 5pm** for the celebration of Vespers in the Poor Clare Colletine Monastery College Road.

The celebration of Vespers on that evening will also be made available on the Diocesan Website for people throughout the Diocese to participate.
