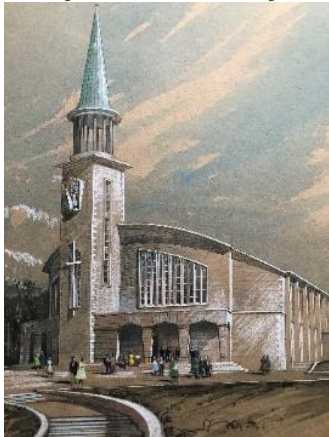

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C



What is your motivation?

Today we continue where we left off last Sunday listening to the first sermon Jesus gives in the Synagogue in Nazareth.

The expectation of the people is running high today – one of their own has made it they are proud of the local boy who comes from a local family. But then something changes – they start to look for more from him – they want miracles and they want them in Nazareth.

Their expectations are changing and Jesus challenges their motivations and in this he asks us to check our own motivations for calling ourselves his followers.

Why are you here? Are you looking for personal favours... are we looking to get something for ourselves... to be seen as better than our neighbours...to have our own needs met first? Or are we here for something more?

We need to ask ourselves these questions – Jesus came to bring Good News to all people, he comes for everyone, no one is excluded, even the outsiders are welcome!

For our part we too are to become Good News for all people, to realise that we too are called to serve others and to make ourselves available to them.

We need to recognise that Jesus is the fulfilment of God's plan and to be willing to play our part today so that the Gospel will continue to be preached and lived in our time and place for all people.

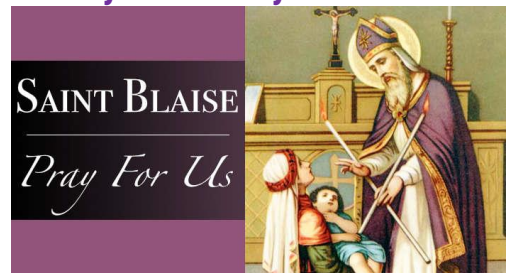
Wednesday 2nd February 2022

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and Candlemas Day – Blessing of Candles

This feast is a remembrance of the Lord and Mary. With candles the people go out to meet the Lord and acclaim him like Simeon who recognised Christ as 'a light to reveal God to the nations'

This is also the traditional day for the Blessing of Candles and will take place on Wednesday at the 9.30am Mass. If you wish to have your candles blessed – please wrap them with your name on them and hand them into the Parish Office or in the basket at the Sacristy Door in the church. After Mass on Wednesday you can collect your blessed candles.

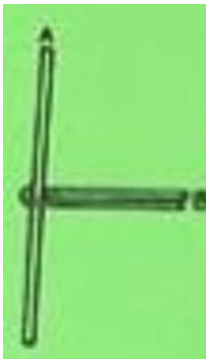

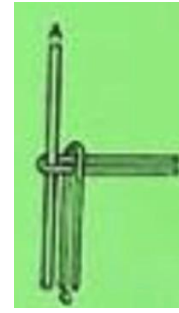
How to make your own St Brigid's Cross

You will need 12 rushes
A scissors
Light wire or string

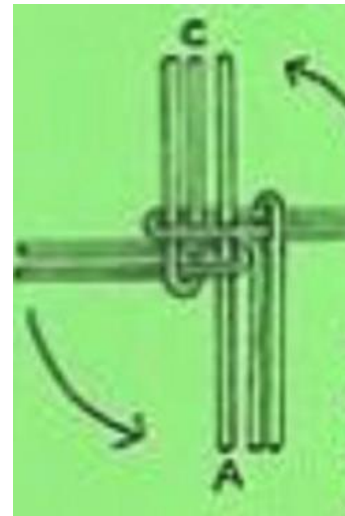
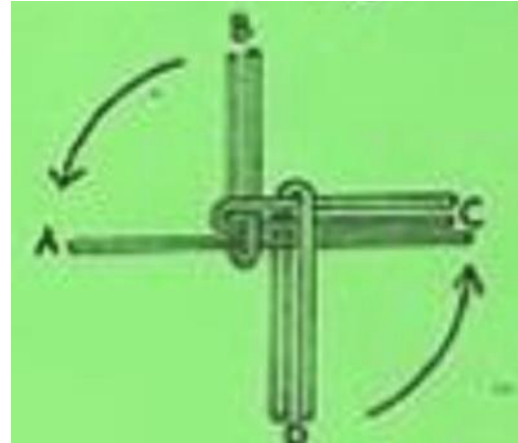
1. Take two long straight rushes – fold one in half and place it over the other straight rush at right angles.



2. Then fold another rush and loop it over as shown. Turn the cross 90 degrees to the left and then fold another rush as shown.



3. Turn again at 90 degrees and continue in this way until the cross is completed and all the twelve rushes have been used



4. Then to finish – tie each leg by using light wire or string to keep it together.
