

## **GOSPEL REFLECTION 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year C**



### **A look in the mirror**

Last week we were invited to engage in a spiritual decluttering of our lives and this week we continue by taking a long hard look at ourselves. So take a moment this week...take a look in the mirror of your daily life...what do you see? Do you like what you see?

Are you seeing yourself clearly? Can you honestly and truthfully say you have no faults? When we look in the mirror each day before facing the world we see the externals – the fine lines, the wrinkles, the imperfect shape of our nose...these can be fixed or accepted as the way God made us, and as testament to our life lived well. Today we are asked to look deeper...to look deep inside our being. Can you say now you have no faults?

I am sure, like me, the list can be made – we are human and we make choices each day, every time we speak or act. So this week let us take stock – what can we change – can we speak with more love and less judgement? Can we offer more encouragement and less negativity? Can we complain less and be more accepting? Can we work for change in ourselves rather than expecting others to change? Can we see the positive, joyful aspects of our life and not just life's difficulties and challenges?

## **Ministry of Altar Server**


**On the first Sunday in March 2022 – we will have the return of Altar Servers in Our Lady Crowned Church.**
