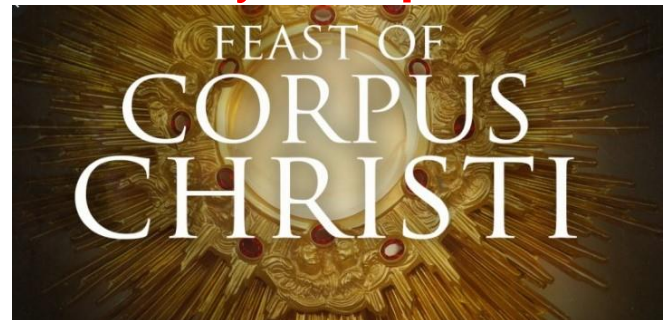

Overwhelmed!

Have you ever felt overwhelmed – perhaps you had planned a meal then other guests turn up and you fear there will not be enough food to go around; or you may wonder if your small contribution to recycling could not possibly make a difference to our planet; perhaps you wonder if your spare change in the Trocaire box could change the life of a family overseas. Sometimes we have to trust – make a small adjustment to the menu and there is enough food for all to share; keep on with our recycling efforts because over time it all adds up to make a difference; keep on putting the small change in the box to give to others.

In our Gospel today we see the disciples overwhelmed too – when Jesus asks them to feed the large crowd he has invited to sit down around him. They took what they had and trusted, following Jesus' instructions, watching and waiting. He took, blessed and broke the bread and shared among all the people – there was enough with much left over! The disciples had to adjust their way of thinking to the way of Jesus just as we are invited to do today. We are to bring our little to the Eucharist and offer it to God, and allow God to do what he wills. Together when we all bring our little to the table of the Lord what might seem impossible to us becomes possible with God's help. With our prayers, our presence, our trust and our small contribution God makes the difference in our world.
