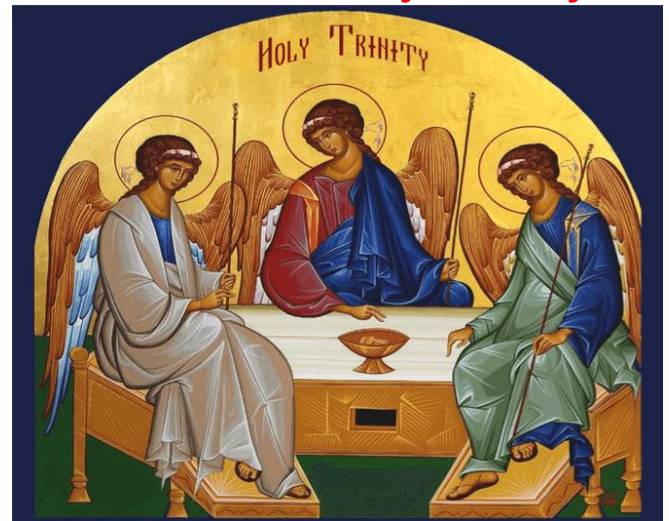

**Gospel Reflection**  
**The Most Holy Trinity**



**It's a Mystery!**

Over the last sixth months we have been reflecting on the Gospels as they reveal God to us. At Christmas we were in Bethlehem celebrating God with us (God becomes man); on Good Friday we were at Calvary – God for us (Jesus gives his life for us) and at Pentecost in the Upper Room we celebrated God in us (the Holy Spirit comes upon us). Today on this feast of the Holy Trinity we bring these three together in the unity of three persons in one God.

Each time we gather we bless ourselves – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – marking this relationship of love that is God. The Father creates, the Son gives life and the Spirit is the love flowing between Father and Son. It is this relationship of love that gives life to us the Christian community who gather here to pray and celebrate together as one people.

Today as the community of Our Lady Crowned Parish we gather to celebrate sixty years of love, of faith, of worship and of service to one another. Our readings today draw us into communion with God, Father, Son and Spirit and with one another. Over sixty years we have lived this relationship with one another – sharing the joys, the sorrows, the challenges and the successes of daily life. We have shared our faith, we have witnessed Christ to others by our words and actions – we have much to celebrate, we are the mystery made visible for one another and for all whom we encounter. Let us continue to share that love as we look to the future united as God's pilgrim people on earth called to be his face, his hands and his feet in our time and place.

At Our Lady Crowned Church a special candle is lighting for your intentions as you sit your exams. May the Spirit of Knowledge & Wisdom be with you during these days.

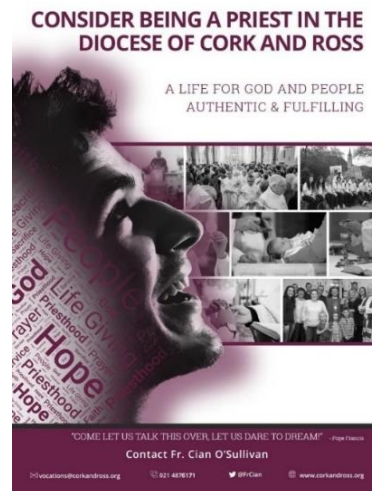
### Second Collection this Weekend
