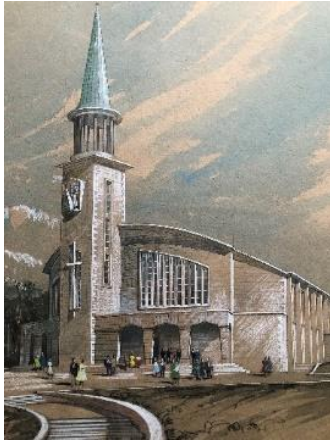

Eight days later... another resurrection

It is now the evening of the resurrection day of Jesus and still the disciples are behind closed doors, hiding in fear of the Jews, even though Jesus has repeatedly told them throughout his time with them 'do not be afraid'. And so, Jesus comes among them again...to move them out of fear and into joy – the joy of the resurrection, which he tells them again they must go and announce to others and to encourage them he gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Sadly, one of them, Thomas, was not with them and he continues to ask for proof that they have seen the Risen Lord. He remains in his unbelief and lack of understanding of all that Jesus taught them. So, eight days later, they continue to remain in the room behind closed doors and Jesus comes among them again. He addresses Thomas in his unbelief and invites him to touch his flesh...and here we witness Thomas' resurrection from doubt to belief...from his world of darkness into the light of one who sees the Risen Jesus.

Eight days later we too are invited to come into the light of one who sees...to look around us to see the Risen Jesus alive and living among us in the everyday smiles...in the touch of love from those around us...in the helping hand offered...in the gathering of this faith community who stand together and say...**I believe...My Lord and my God.**
