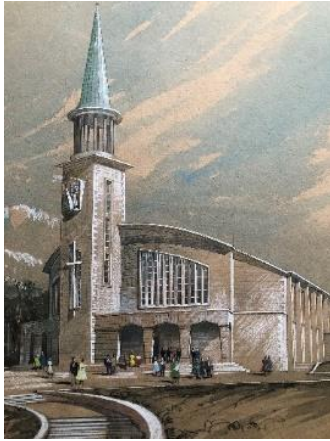

Gospel Reflection

3rd Sunday of Easter 2023



Encounters...

Today our Gospel is the familiar story of the two disciples on the road from Jerusalem to the village of Emmaus. **Today I want to invite each of us to look at this Gospel in a different way – to explore the four parts of our Mass through the lens of this encounter on the road.**

1.The encounter on the road between the two disciples and Jesus mirrors the gathering of the assembly. Together they share their story and make connections just as we come together in the church and join our story with the story of others with whom we gather for Mass.

2.The sharing of the Word of God – the two disciples share with Jesus all that they have witnessed in Jerusalem and then Jesus explains the scriptures to them beginning with Moses. This mirrors our listening to and hearing explained to us the readings of the day.

3.Moving deeper into the story of Emmaus, the two disciples invite Jesus to stay with them for a meal. In this moment at the table Jesus moves from being their guest to being their host as he takes the bread, blesses it and breaks it and then takes the cup and blesses it and shares it with them. And so they share Eucharist together just as we do each time we gather for Mass.

4.As the disciples feel their hearts burn within them, they recognise Jesus is with them and within them so they are moved to go and tell others who they have encountered on their journey and all that they have witnessed on the road. We too are sent out at the end of Mass, we too become what we receive and are sent forth to go and tell others. **Let us together read this story anew each time we gather for Mass in our parish...**
