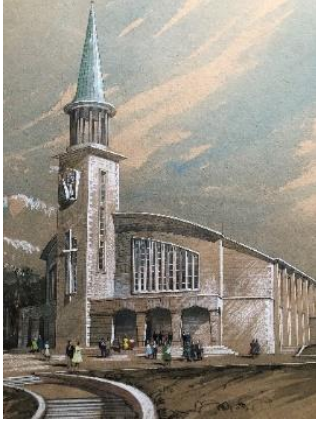

On this great feast we see the culmination of Jesus' life on earth as the apostles witness him returning to his father but before he goes away from them he commissions them for the work he called them to do. He gives them authority to baptise and teach all people of all nations.
