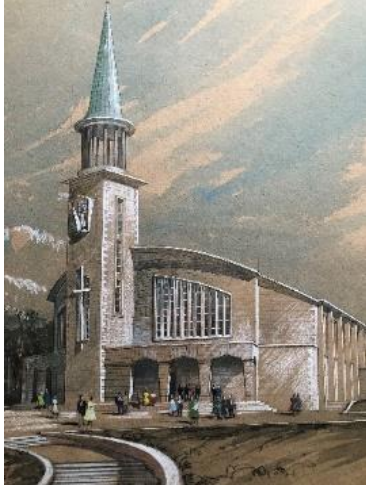

Gospel Reflection

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ Year A



Called and sent...

Our Gospel today comes in two parts...Jesus notices that the people need direction, they need witnesses among them...they need leaders in their midst and so he asks for prayer to God that more labourers will come forth to work in his vineyard among the people. To continue to pray for...encourage, support and inspire vocations to ministry in the Church is at the heart of this first part of the Gospel today.

As we celebrate priesthood in our parish we are called to turn in fervent prayer to God that men will continue to hear and respond generously to the call to ministry among the people today who continue to seek direction, witnesses and leaders in their midst.

The Gospel today is also a moment of transition when the focus shifts from the ministry of Jesus to the work of the community that he has inaugurated. More than any other Gospel, Matthew's Gospel elaborates on the work of the Church, which is to continue after Jesus' death and resurrection. So, part two of the Gospel sees the call of the apostles and their commissioning to go out among the people and in turn that same call is to us, the Church, to continue that same mission, rooted in our Baptism, when we too are commissioned to hear and proclaim the Gospel in our daily life in our words and actions. We too are called to give freely just as we have freely received from the Lord.

As we celebrate today with Frs Kerry, Tomás and Colin we give thanks for their willingness to say Yes to the Call from God...to go out among the people sometimes far from their homes to new places among strangers who through their ministry become friends. They have given their lives in the Service of the Gospel... may we continue to pray for vocations and to witness to the Gospel each day.

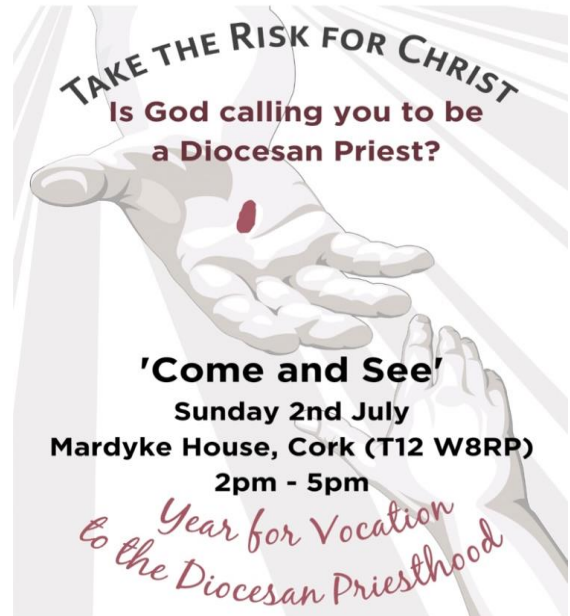
