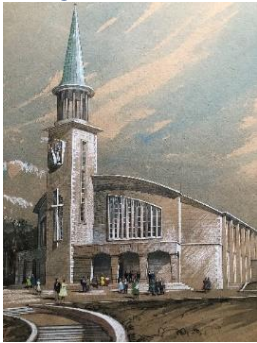

Gospel Reflection



A love that helps us to grow...

Do you recall as a child when a sibling or friend did something wrong to you running to a parent or teacher and telling them about it, expecting them to deal with it for you? We see this very scenario in today's Gospel – but Jesus invites us to deal with it differently – as an adult ought to do, in the way of fraternal correction.

Jesus asks us to acknowledge the wrong or the hurt and to go to the person and speak with them alone about it – not to air their sin in public without first having a conversation with them. This way is not always easy...nor is it always met with a listening ear. Sometimes you will be met with anger or denial – still we are asked by Jesus to invite them to think about their ways and to choose to change and grow in love. He goes on to say that if this one-to-one conversation fails bring two others with you – not as judge and jury but to assist in bringing about change in behaviour. Only if this too fails should you go to the wider community to air your grievance. Never should our first recourse be to tell others, this is to gossip, and Pope Francis often reminds us that gossip is destructive to love and to community. The one who gossips to others becomes the one who hurts and who is in the wrong.

So today consider **'what is my approach to someone who hurts me or does wrong to me?'** Will you take the way of love and growth – approach them and work it out between yourselves? This is the way of Jesus, the way of growing together in love.

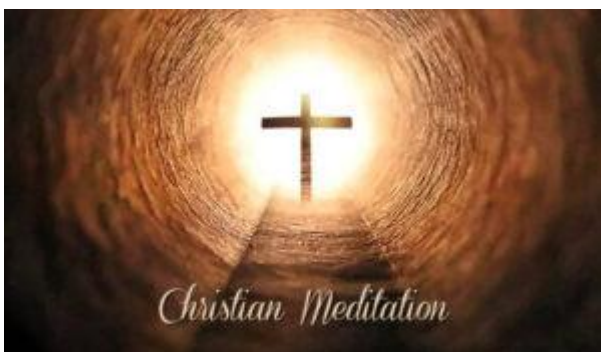
