Gospel Reflection

Three...

Not the mobile and internet provider but rather the movements of today's Gospel. The reading from Mark is set over three times during the one day and takes into three different situations which all have something to teach us about life and hope.

Day time/Family: it is day-time and Jesus responds to the request to go Simon's house where his mother-in-law is sick. Here Jesus says nothing but takes her hand and she rises from the bed, the fever is gone. **Evening time/community:** Jesus responds to all whom come from the wider community seeking healing because they had heard about him from others. **Dawn/alone time:** Jesus goes away by himself to pray – seeking strength for another day of meeting with people, teaching, preaching healing all who come to him.

And so it is for us, while we might not be called on to heal people there are many people who call on our time each day and we respond in a myriad of different ways to their needs. We need family to root and ground us, to hand on faith to us, to support us when we are sick or in need, to rejoice with us when we celebrate. We need community to share our faith, to support us to teach us how to care and love each other as neighbour. We need alone time with God to renew us, to inspire us and to refresh our faith. So at the end of each day take a moment to reflect on your time, the people who shared the hours of the day with you and who you can bring to the Lord in quiet prayer seeking hope and new life.
