Gospel Reflection: Three actions of relationship

Today's Gospel is at its heart about building relationships through three actions. Think about your own relationships with those you love – you look at them, you touch them affectionately and you eat with them.

This is what Jesus is asking of his disciples today – firstly, that they look at him. Not just a quick glance and turn away, rather to look and to see willingly. It is to look with tenderness and love at him – to look at him with intention to see all of him and in looking come to close to him, to get to know him.

Secondly, he invites them to touch him. As humans we are relational beings who find comfort in the touch of another person. It shows affection, tenderness, and love. Jesus in inviting his disciples to touch him is calling them to come close to him not to remain at a distance but to touch and feel his presence beside them.

Thirdly, he invites them to share a meal with him. Eating together is sign of love, of affection, and of relationship. Over meals we share our intimate thoughts and ideas with those we love and so Jesus wants to share all of life with his disciples over a meal.

So today as you reflect on this Gospel, think about those you love – those whom you look at, those you touch and those you eat with. Then ask yourself do I intentionally come to Jesus with these same actions – it is in looking at him, in touching him, in sharing the Eucharistic meal he offers to us that we will deepen our relationship with him.

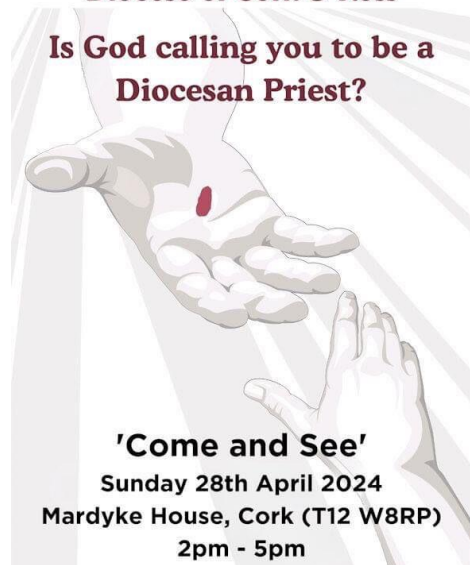
